

## **PCHA Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper Championship Specs**

Open to horse/rider combinations from the PCHA Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper Standings as of October 16, 2017. Horses, riders, trainer, and owners must be current members of PCHA. Classes to count at each show include the Children's Jumpers, Adult Amateur Jumpers, and the Child/Adult Amateur Jumper Classics. Each horse/rider combination must have competed in one other class on a recognized show day prior to the championship during the Del Mar International World Cup Week. Horse/Rider combinations may not have competed above 1.20m during the 2017 show season. Riders may not have competed above 1.30m during 2017 show season.

## **PCHA Children's/ Adult Amateur Hunter Championship Specs**

Open to Child/Adult Amateur horse/rider combinations from the PCHA Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter Standings. All horses, riders, owners and trainers must be current PCHA members. Classes to count at each show include the Children's Hunters, Adult Amateur Hunters and the Children/ Adult Amateur Hunter Classics. Each Horse/rider must have competed in one other class prior to the championship during the Del Mar International Welcome Week. All entries will compete in a first round on Saturday October 14, and the top 25 horse/rider combinations to compete for the championship on Sunday, October 15. The order of go for the first round will be in reverse order of points from the PCHA Children's Adult Hunter Standings as of October 9, 2017. The second round will be in reverse order of points in the first round. Fences 3'.
